

Badger Yellow Oat

Agronomic Information

Badger is an early season yellow seeded oat variety with medium plant height. Badger has high yield potential and excellent test weights. It has good straw strength and lodging resistance. Badger is resistant to crown rust and has good tolerance to barley yellow dwarf virus. Badger yielded 95.0 Bu/acre in the 2014 MSU oat trials.

Marketing Information

Released in 2010, Badger oats are exclusively licensed to Wisconsin Crop Improvement Association (WCIA). MCIA has signed an agreement to act as WCIA legal agent to license Michigan producers who want to produce Badger oats for sale as certified seed in Michigan. Badger oats are protected under the **Plant Variety Protection Act - Title V**. Seed of this variety can only be sold by variety name as a class of certified seed.
