

# *Coral Soft White Winter Wheat*

## Genetic Information

Coral (E2017) is a new awnless, bronze chaffed, high yielding soft white winter wheat variety developed at Michigan State University. Coral exhibits a stable and high level of performance, broad adaptation, and resistance/tolerance to many plant diseases. Coral has excellent resistant to wheat spindle streak mosaic virus. Coral has very good disease scores for septoria leaf blotch and barley yellow dwarf virus. Coral has **improved scab resistance and very low DON levels** compared to the available white wheat varieties currently being planted.

## Agronomic Information

Coral is a mid-season high yielding soft white winter wheat with **exceptional winter hardiness**. Coral has proven to consistently have very good test weights. Coral has medium height averaging 35.0 inches.

Coral had the **fifth highest three year yield average** of all white wheat varieties tested in the MSU 2008 wheat trials. Coral has potential to become an important wheat in Michigan.

## Marketing Information

Coral wheat was evaluated by the USDA Soft Wheat Quality Lab in Wooster and found to have very good milling and baking scores.

Coral will be sold by variety name as a class of Certified Seed. Authorized seed classes will be Breeder, Foundation, and Certified. Coral soft white winter wheat is marketed and sold by members of the Michigan Crop Improvement Association through a licensing agreement. A royalty fee will be assessed on each unit of seed sold. Coral seed will be inspected and certified by MCIA inspectors to insure a high quality product.
