

D6234 Soft White Wheat

Genetic Information

MSU D6234 is a soft white winter wheat developed by Michigan State University. MSU D6234 is an awnless white chaffed soft white winter wheat variety. Its plant height is average with good lodging resistance. MSU D6234 is not known to differ in winter survival from other common varieties. MSU D6234 has good resistance to wheat spindle streak mosaic virus. MSU D6234 has excellent test weight for a soft white wheat variety.

Agronomic Features

MSU D6234 has shown very good yield potential. MSU D6234's three year average yield in the 2008 MSU wheat trials is 88.7 bu. / acre. MSU D6234 has performed well through the state.

Marketing

MSU D6234 has exhibited acceptable scores for milling and baking qualities, similar to other varieties commonly grown in Michigan.

MSU D6234 will be sold by variety name as a class of Certified Seed. Authorized seed classes will be Breeder, Foundation, and Certified. MSU D6234 has a royalty assessed on each unit of certified seed sold.
