

Horsepower White Oat

Agronomic Information

Horsepower is an early to mid-season white seeded oat variety developed by the South Dakota Agricultural Experiment Station. Horsepower has high yield potential and strong straw strength and lodging resistance. Horsepower is short in plant height and has average test weights. Horsepower is moderately resistant to crown rust, smut, and barley yellow dwarf virus. Horsepower is moderately susceptible to stem rust. Horsepower was the highest yielding oat variety in the 2014 MSU oat trials at 104.7 Bu/acre.

Marketing Information

Released in 2013, Horsepower have a 30 cent/ bushel royalty assessed on each bushel sold as certified seed. MCIA has signed an agreement to act as SDSU legal agent to license and collect the royalty from Michigan producers. Horsepower oats are protected under the **Plant Variety Protection Act - Title V**. Seed of this variety can only be sold by variety name as a class of certified seed.
