

Shelby 427 White Oat

Agronomic Information

Shelby 427 is a mid-season, high yielding oat variety developed by the South Dakota Agricultural Experiment Station. Shelby 427 has high yield potential, high groat percentage and a high test weight. It is a medium tall variety with good pledging resistance. Shelby 427 is resistant to BYDV and crown rust and has moderate resistance to smut and stem rust.

Marketing Information

Released in 2010, Shelby 427 oats have a 30 cent/ bushel royalty assessed on each bushel sold as certified seed. MCIA has signed an agreement to act as SDSU legal agent to license and collect the royalty from Michigan producers. Shelby 427 oats are protected under the **Plant Variety Protection Act - Title V**. Seed of this variety can only be sold by variety name as a class of certified seed.
