

Ogle Yellow Oats

Agronomic Information

Ogle is a stable, widely adapted, early maturing yellow oat variety with excellent resistance to barley yellow dwarf virus. Ogle has excellent lodging resistance and matures in approximately 111 days. Ogle is susceptible to rusts and loose smut. Ogle yielded 82.4 Bu/acre in the 2014 MSU oat trials.
