

Streeter Soybean

Genetic Information

Streeter is a new 3.0 relative maturity soybean variety released from the Ohio Agricultural Research and Development Center.

Streeter was released for its excellent lodging resistance and is very high yielding. Streeter has both the Rps1c and Rps3a alleles that give it a high level of partial resistance to phytophthora root rot.

Agronomic Information

Streeter is an indeterminate early group 3 variety. It has white flowers, light tawny pubescence, and tan pods. Seeds are dull yellow with black hila. Streeter has shown very good resistance to lodging, making it a good variety for narrow row plantings.

Marketing Information

Streeter is available from certified seed producers in Michigan. It is released with a royalty assessment of \$.60 per 60# on all certified seed.
