

# *Wyandot Soybean*

## **Genetic Information**

Wyandot is a new 2.9 relative maturity soybean variety released from the Ohio Agricultural Research and Development Center.

Wyandot was released for its high yielding ability to replace Sandusky soybeans. Wyandot has a clear hilum with food grade potential averaging 2600 seeds per pound. Wyandot has Rps3 gene that give it resistance to phytophthora root and stem rot.

## **Agronomic Information**

Wyandot is an indeterminate late group 2 variety. It has white flowers, gray pubescence, and brown pods. Seeds are dull yellow with yellow hila. Wyandot has shown very good resistance to lodging, making it a good variety for narrow row plantings.

## **Marketing Information**

Wyandot is available from certified seed producers in Michigan. It is released with a royalty assessment of \$.60 per 60# on all certified seed.
