

Jupiter Soft White Wheat

Genetic Information

Jupiter is a new awnleted, bronze chaffed high yielding soft white winter wheat variety developed at Michigan State University. Jupiter exhibits a stable and high level of performance, broad adaptation, and resistance/tolerance to many plant diseases. Jupiter has excellent resistant to powdery mildew and stripe rust.

Agronomic Features

Jupiter is a mid-season high yielding soft white winter wheat with exceptional winter hardiness. Jupiter is of short stature giving it very good lodging resistance. Jupiter was the 2nd highest yielding white wheat variety (85.5 bu./acre) and had the highest four year yield average of all white wheat varieties tested in the MSU 2018 wheat trials. Jupiter has become a dominate wheat here in Michigan.

Marketing

Jupiter wheat was evaluated by the USDA Soft Wheat Quality Lab in Wooster and found to have acceptable milling and baking scores. Jupiter is protected by Plant variety protection (PVP94) under Title V. Seed of Jupiter soft white winter wheat can only be sold by variety name as a class of certified seed. Jupiter soft white winter wheat is marketed and sold by members of the Michigan Crop Improvement Association through a licensing agreement. A royalty fee will be assessed on each unit of seed sold. Jupiter seed will be inspected and certified by MCIA inspectors to insure a high quality product.
